

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS SNOW REMOVAL AND WINTER PARKING

Residents are reminded that restrictions on snow removal and street parking are in effect during the winter months.

Please do not deposit snow on public roadways. Pushing or blowing snow and ice onto or across public roadways creates an unsafe situation for drivers and can be punishable by fine under **Section 181 of the Highway Traffic Act**.

Please do not leave vehicles parked or standing on a public roadway. By doing so, you create an unsafe situation for drivers and interfere with traffic movement and snow removal efforts.

Pursuant to the Town's *Parking and Traffic By-Law 4308-09, and the Repair and Storage Liens Act R.S.O. 1990 c. R25,* Enforcement Officers will be serving parking infraction notices and towing away any vehicle found parked on public streets in Niagara-on-the-Lake as follows:

- Directly interferes with traffic movement or snow removal
- In excess of 12 hours at any one time
- In contravention of "No Parking" zones
- Within 10 metres of an intersection
- Within 3 metres of a fire hydrant

Please be a good neighbour and consider the safety of other road users.

We also ask parents to remind their children to be aware of snow plowing operations and the hazards posed by extreme winter driving conditions, such as reduced visibility and increased vehicle stopping distances.
